



# 1.2. Brief History of UMTY



1960-1964	Establishment of 4-year degree course for Physiotherapy with the collaboration of British Colombo Plan and Department of Health (Physiotherapy training in UK)
1964 December	Foundation of School of Paramedical Sciences, Yangon
1964-1986	Four-year diploma courses for Physiotherapy, Medical Laboratory, Radiography and Pharmacy at Yangon General Hospital
1986-1991	Two-year diploma courses for Physiotherapy, Medical Laboratory, Radiography
1991 December	Foundation of Institute of Paramedical Sciences (IPMS) in Kamayut, Yangon
1991-1993	Two-year bridge course for degree of Physiotherapy, Medical Laboratory, Radiography

1993 December	Opening of 4-year degree courses for Physiotherapy, Medical Laboratory, Radiography according to university entrance selection criteria
2001 January	Opening of new campus in Aung San, Insein, Yangon
2003 December	Establishment of 2-year Master's Programs for Physiotherapy, medical Laboratory and Radiography
2005 January	From IPMS to University of Medical Technology, Yangon (UMTY) From Medical Laboratory to Medical Laboratory Technology (MLT) From Radiography to Medical Imaging Technology (MIT))
2008 May	Relocation of all departments from Kamayut campus to Aung San, Insein campus
2015 January	Establishment of the Department of Prosthetic & Orthotic supported by Nippon Foundation and the Cambodia Trust

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









# 2. PHYSIOTHERAPY EDUCATION SYSTEM




